Reorganisation of the Shropshire Community Safety Partnership

Objective 5: To reduce the number of fires and malicious calls to the emergency services

Local Partnership actions: Current

- Providing student education and awareness to reduce the number of malicious calls.
- Continuing house to house safety inspections to raise awareness about the dangers of fire.
- Providing student education and awareness to reduce arson fires on schools.
- Raising awareness about the detrimental effect of calls to the emergency services.

Local Partnership actions: Future

- Provide arson awareness and avoidance information to the farming and business communities.
- Community Support Officers to identify and encourage residents to have smoke alarms fitted.
- To investigate the feasibility of a mutual aid – local businesses to support one another to trade after fire damage incident.

Objective 6: To reduce re-offending

Local Partnership actions: Current

- Screening of young offenders for offences of violence and targeting with appropriate programmes.

Local Partnership actions: Future

- Supervise community orders and post-release licenses
- Implement the accredited violent offender programme as soon as it is available.
- To establish a Countywide Prolific and other Priority Offender (PPO) strategy.

Objective 7: To improve drug education and advice for young people

Local Partnership actions: Current

- Working with the Drug Action Team to implement their Young People's Plan – ongoing.
- Developing a solvent campaign in partnership with the Substance Misuse Team and Drug Action Team.

Local Partnership actions: Future

- Diversionary activities for young people in North Shrewsbury, including sports and a music event.
- Develop a closer working relationship with the Drug Action Team through a countywide arrangement, including an information sharing protocol.
- To develop an Anti - Cannabis
