

## SECTION TWO – STAFFING - RETAINED STATIONS

### CREWING LEVELS

The same minimum crewing levels apply as for wholetime appliances.

- **Two Appliance Station**

Rescue Pump	WrL
5	4

- **XL Cab Station**

XL Status	WrL
8	4

Although the minimum crewing level for an XL Cab appliance when below the XL status is 4 it should be noted that as XL Cab appliances have Rescue Pump equipment and therefore the minimum crewing level should normally be 5. However there will be the need for intelligent mobilising to an incident where a Rescue Pump is required if the crewing level falls below 5.

### RETAINED APPLIANCE CREWING LEVELS (ONE OR MORE BELOW MINIMUM CREWING)

- **Two-Appliance Station with special appliance(s)**

5	4	Alternately crewed with WrL

- **Two-Appliance Station**

Rescue Pump	WrL
6	Off The Run

- **Single Appliance Station with special appliance(s)**

WrL	Specials
4	Alternately crewed with WrL

No firefighter is to proceed to an incident independent of an appliance **but in specific circumstances on XL Cab stations personnel may be mobilised by Fire Control to incidents in the Ford Ranger (*Brigade Order Operations No 2 Part 3 Mobilising*)**.

Where only three personnel are available, retained appliance maybe mobilised as a “supernumerary pump” in accordance with **Brigade Order Health and Safety No 2 Part 4 Supernumerary Pumps Risk Assessment**.
