

SECTION FIVE – HEAT RESISTANT GLOVES

INTRODUCTION

Heat resistant gloves are provided to give thermal protection to the wearer when handling heated objects.

STANDARD ISSUE

One pair to each appliance.

USE

The gloves will most commonly be used in conjunction with chimney gear when removing a fire basket etc., from a hearth. The gloves are **not** to be used as debris gloves.

CLEANING

The gloves should be cleaned using a mild hand soap. A stiff bristle brush may help remove some of the embedded grit and grime.

DRYING

Should be air dried in the same manner as Firecraft gloves.

INSPECTION AND TESTING

The gloves should be inspected regularly and replaced as required.
