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PART 2 - FALSE ALARMS

PURPOSE

This Brigade Order sets out the way in which Shropshire Fire and Rescue Service will reduce the number of both unwanted fire alarm signals generated by automatic systems and those resulting from malicious or hoax calls. The Order clarifies the roles and responsibilities of all personnel in respect of these aims.

STRATEGIC AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Implementation of this Brigade Order will support the following strategic aims and associated corporate objectives:

Strategic Aim 1 - Reduce the risk to life and material loss from fire and other emergencies in the community.

Strategic Aim 2 – Protect life, property and the environment from fire and other emergencies.

Strategic Aim 3 – Secure the highest level of safety and welfare for all staff by providing effective supervision, training, equipment and systems of work.

Strategic Aim 4 – Provide a service that demonstrates quality and best value in service provision.

Corporate Objective 2 - Reduce the Incidence of fire and false alarms.

Corporate Objective 4 – Increase the occasions on which the national standards of fire cover are met.

Corporate Objective 5 – Ensure the provision of an appropriate response to non-fire emergencies.

Corporate Objective 7 – ensure that all employees are competent and able to perform their role.

Corporate Objective 9 – ensure the provision of a service that meets the needs of the community.

ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES AND REVIEW

The **Deputy Chief Fire Officer** is responsible for ensuring this Order is implemented across the Brigade.

The **Fire Safety Enforcement District Officer** will be responsible for the day to day operation of the Order.

The **Fire Safety Enforcement District Officer** will review this order annually in *June* and as and when organisational changes take place.
