Review of Financial Regulations

1 Purpose of Report

This report asks members to consider and agree the draft Financial Regulations and the updated virement and debt write off levels, following officer review.

2 Recommendations

The Fire Authority is asked to

- Consider the revised Financial Regulations and approve their adoption, and
- b) Consider the proposed changes to virement levels and debt write off levels and approve their adoption.

3 Background

As part of its constitution the Fire Authority has in place the following documents:

- Scheme of Delegation to Officers;
- Standing Orders for the Regulation of Proceedings and Business;
- Standing Orders relating to Contracts; and
- Financial Regulations Standing Orders.

Although not a legal requirement, it is deemed good practice for local authorities to review these documents on a regular basis. In October 2015, officers presented a set of Financial Regulations to the Authority, based on a model set from the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA). These replaced the previous, more condensed regulations which were in place and provided one comprehensive document which detailed the responsibilities and processes required for the sound financial management of the Authority.

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4 Review

Officers have again reviewed the Financial Regulations and a link to the updated document is contained within the report. In order to provide practical guidance on how the Regulations should be interpreted and applied, detailed procedure notes are held in each department. Officers should ensure that these procedure notes are updated to remain in line with the Regulations.

Officers recommend that the revised Financial Regulations be adopted, with any subsequent amendments brought to the Fire Authority as need arises.

As the proposed amendments to the Financial Regulations are minor, the document has not been attached to this report, in order to save paper and postage. The current version can be viewed on the Service's website via the following link:

5 Review of Virement and Debt Write Off Limits

Officers have also taken the opportunity to review the current rules in place around approving virements and writing off doubtful debts.

The current limits have not been reviewed for a number years and it is now considered that they do not reflect or assist current working practices. The changes proposed will enable decisions to be made more quickly, with more local and devolved responsibility.
