1 Purpose of Report

This report presents the proposed internet / web based Service Plan for 2013/14.

2 Recommendation

The Fire Authority is asked to consider and approve the proposed Service Plan 2013/14.

3 Background

In recent years the Fire Authority, largely through the Public Value process, has sought to simplify and streamline the content and publication of the annual Service Plan. The Service Plan acts as a forward looking document, setting out the Authority's purpose, priorities, aims and performance measures for Shropshire Fire and Rescue Service. The Plan is supplemented by a backward looking Annual Report¹ that summarises the Authority's performance against the contents of the previous year's Plan.

During 2012 the Coalition Government published a new Fire and Rescue Service National Framework², which has implications for the Authority's previous approach to the development and publication of both the Service Plan and Annual Report. The implications identified were presented to the Fire Authority earlier this year, with agreement reached that the Strategy and Resources Committee will continue to oversee preparation of the Service Plan, and the Audit and Performance Management Committee will oversee the Annual Report.
